 - 1) Motivation and statement of willingness to become: Executive Editor for Letters (12-15 hrs. average weekly workload), or TPEL Co-Editor-in-Chief (6-8 hrs. average weekly workload)
 - 2) Prior services on Editorial Boards in IEEE
 - 3) Technical Committee activities
 - 4) Brief statement of research areas and types of papers comfortable to handle as a Co-EiC.
- B. Include also a brief 1-2 page resume/CV.

Interviews may be held with short listed candidates.
