  - 2) Prior services on Editorial Boards in IEEE
  - 3) Technical Committee activities
  - 4) Possibility for host institution/company support for the candidate for the Co-EiC position (e.g. release time, financial resources, etc.)
  - 5) For Co-EiC applicants, brief statement of research areas and types of papers comfortable to handle.
  - 6) Names and contact information of three references.
- B. Include also a brief 2-page resume/CV.

Interviews may be held with short listed candidates.
